Nearly 10,000 guests attend the Harwich Cranberry Arts and Music Festival every year. Local bands take the stage and artisan crafts are on display. September 19-20 in Brooks Park.

615

The Harwich Conservation Trust oversees 615 acres of protected wilderness in town. Visit harwichconservationtrust.org to see the different properties and map out your next trail adventure.

1953

The Harwich Historical Society has been chronicling the town’s unique history since 1953. The society’s collection, housed at the Brooks Academy Museum, includes a sweet cranberry exhibit.

55

Schoolhouse Ice Cream and Yogurt offers 55 flavors of homemade ice cream including Red Sox-centric Cherry Remy, Brady Bunch Crunch (after the Patriots QB) and cranberry bog.

120

The Wequassett Resort and Golf Club offers 120 lavish guest rooms, four restaurants, two pools and two beaches—and endless views of scenic Pleasant Bay.

72

Par for Harwich’s 18-hole Cranberry Valley Golf Course is a score of 72. The course was the site of the 2014 Massachusetts Golf Association’s Amateur Public Links Championship.

ONE

Cowboy up! Former Red Sox slugger, Kevin Millar, played for the Harwich Mariners of the Cape League for one season (1992). Be sure to catch a Mariners game this summer.

Four

Harwich has four harbors, but just one—Round Cove—is natural. Wychmere, Allen, and Saquatucket harbors were once ponds, or marshes that were dredged out to Nantucket Sound.

18

The Harwich Farmers Market offers Cape-grown produce and locally made products for 18 weeks from mid-June to mid-October. Held at Brooks Park on Thursdays from 3-6 p.m.

4, 5

Dancing in the street is encouraged at the Harwichport Musical Stroll. On four Wednesdays in July and August, five bands play simultaneously at spots between Bank and South Streets.

190

The Saquatucket Municipal Harbor Marina has berths for 190 motorboats, charter fishing boats, and sailboats; short-term visitor slips are also available.

250, \$15

Red River Beach is the town’s largest beach with lifeguards and bathroom facilities available in summer. The parking lot has spaces for 250 cars and a pass (\$15) is required.

Harwich is home to 22 freshwater ponds, including Sand Pond, Long Pond Beach, Fernandes Bog, and Wixon Memorial Beach.
